**AMENDMENT TO THE MOTION OF THANKS TO THE
GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS TO BE MOVED IN THE HOUSE**

(1) S/Shri O. Joy Singh and R.K. Anand, MLAs:

1. That it is regretted that the State Government has failed to implement the 6th pay commission report approved by the Government of India w.e.f. 1-2-2006 thereby creating unnecessary problems to the Government employees thus affecting the working/functioning of the Government.
2. That the address failed to mention a concrete rehabilitation measures specially organized rehabilitation centers run by the State Government as the youth of the State is important asset of the state where as the drug abuse is a great issue affecting the youth of the State. And also it failed to mention about a clear-cut youth policy of the State.
3. That it also failed to mention about a single word about the Armed Forces Special Power Act 1958.
4. That the address did not mention specific measure to reduce corrupt practices & thereby increasing the inefficiency of the Government.
5. That the global warming & climate changes has affected agricultural crop production, water availability & overall environment. The address did not mention even a single word on this issue.
6. That various professional services are not well organized & they need special attention of the Government so that their service conditions are taken care of by the Government. In this regard the address is completely silent. Manipur Education Services and Manipur Engineering Services be created so that competent manpower are groomed in a planned way.
7. That the Vision document 2020 has identified the economy gap of 30% between the North Eastern States including Manipur & the National Average. It also has warned to step the Annual Growth Rate of State Domestic product by 1.75% more during 2007-2012, 4.25% more during 2012-2017 and 6.75 more during 2017-2020 than the National Average of 9%. But the address failed to mention about a concrete target and its achievement.
