MURDER OF Y. KRISHNADAS SINGH:

Krishnadas Singh was kidnapped from his residence at Thangmeiband on 9-6-2009 and later on found murdered on 12-6-2009;	(a) On 10-6-2009 at 11.05 p.m. Keisham Gopal Singh (66) of Thangmeiband Khomdram Selungba Leikai lodged a written report with OC Imphal P.S. stating that on the same day at about 10 p.m. his son-in-law namely Yengkhom Krishnadas Singh(42) s/o (L) Ballop Singh of Kakching Sumang Leikai was kidnapped by 4/5 unknown armed persons. It refers to case FIR No. 188(6)09 u/s 365/34 IPC&25 (1-B) A. Act of Imphal P.S. Later on the dead body of Y. Krishnadas was found at Lilong Chajing Chingthak near water supply on 12-06-2009. It refers to case FIR No. 31(6)09 u/s 302/34 IPC & 25(1-C) A Act of Lilong P.S.
