(a) whether it is true that the S.O.O. (Suspension of Operation) was signed between GOI, GOM and Kuki groups; and	(a) Yes.
(b) if so, the ground rules thereof?	(b) Ground Rules with both organizations i.e. Kuki National Organisation (KNO) and the United Peoples' Front (UPF) have been signed separately. The Ground Rules provide, in brief, that the Suspension of Operations will be in force for one year w.e.f. 22-08-2008. While two groups have agreed to abjure the path of violence, the Security Forces and State Police will not launch operations against the two groups. A Joint Monitoring Group has been set up to oversee implementation of Suspension of Operations. Cards of the two groups will be accommodated in the designated camps. Any violations will be taken up by the Joint Monitoring Group. Reasonable amount, as per Govt. norms have been paid by the Govt. for maintenance of the cadres of the two groups who stay in the designated camps. Vocational training is also proposed to be provided to the cadres.
